STANDING ORDERS: CRIMINAL 347TH DISTRICT COURT, NUECES COUNTY, TEXAS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019

Defendants are required to appear at all court settings unless specifically excused by the Judge. All parties must abide by the 347th District Court dress code which is posted on the Nueces County website and courtroom doors.

<u>Arraignment Setting:</u> The Court does not accept Waivers of Arraignment.

<u>Pre-Trial Motions:</u> Pre-Trial hearings shall be scheduled not less than two (2) weeks prior to trial. The Court will not hear any Pre-Trial matters beyond this deadline.

All other Motions: All matters set out in Article 28.01 T.C.C.P.

Motion for Continuances: Motions for Continuance must be filed seven (7) days prior to the Docket Call hearing with a Certificate of Service and acknowledgment by the Defendant. Agreed Motions for Continuance will be accepted by submission. The Court requires a hearing on all motions which are not agreed by Prosecution and Defense. If defense counsel asks another attorney to make their announcement. He/she must be ready for resolve any issue that arise.

Docket Call: Defendants are required to attend Docket Call.

<u>Jury Trial:</u> The Court does accept plea agreements on the day jury trial is set. The defense attorney is responsible for ensuring that the defendant has clothes for trial and must follow Nueces County jail procedures for providing clothes to defendant in custody.
