NUECES COUNTY STANDING ORDER REGARDING WAIVERS OF ARRAIGNMENT

Due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) crisis and to ensure the health and safety of the public, court staff(s), and litigants, the District Court Judges and County Courts at Law Judges of Nueces County, during a specially called meeting on March 17, 2020, adopted the following resolution regarding Waivers of Arraignments which have been scheduled between March 20, 2020 and April 24, 2020.

IT IS THEREBY ORDERED that all Courts will accept paper Waivers of Arraignment for defendants called to appear for arraignment between March 20, 2020 and April 24, 2020. Waivers must contain the signatures of both the Defendant and Attorney on the Court's written notice of settings, acknowledging notice and receipt of court settings. Otherwise, Attorneys and Defendants must appear at Arraignment.

THIS NUECES COUNTY STANDING ORDER SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON 17th DAY OF MARCH, 2020 and will apply to all District Courts and County Courts at Law in Nueces County.




